There will be no music outside the home after 10PM. This event is not open to the public. It is a by invitation only event and attendance will be limited.

100% of the proceeds will go to Make A Difference Foundation which is a Non-Profit Corporation dedicated to raising awareness and supporting charitable causes. This dedication takes place in the form of scholarships, financial contributions and non-profit setup and creation. Our mission is twofold: The first is to immediately help causes that are near and dear to our hearts and the second is to mentor other charities in hopes of creating more self-sustaining, recognizable non-profits that can lead others in the future.

This Charity Event is in loving Memory of Leah Waichulis dear friend of the Odland's. Leah was 34 when she lost her year+ battle with Stage IV Pancreatic Cancer on May 27, 2016. She was always smiling, even in a hospital bed. She lived the epitome of a healthy lifestyle, was out in nature and exercising her whole battle with cancer and before. Her husband, Pete, at her side the whole time, tirelessly researching and hunting for a cure for her. They were a wonderful couple loving their rescue cat, Snotty, who battled Leukemia.

Details about the residence and security:

The house has perimeter walls and gates for security. The one side gate will be locked to permit entry and exit only through the front door. Alcohol will not be allowed outside the front of the home. There will be security and a registration table before entry into the front door. Registration and lanyards will designate those allowed for entry. Security will be out front and inside. Attendees must be 21 or older to enter and registration will validate. The number of security will be between 2-4 depending upon the final number of attendees. Beer, wine and mixed drinks will be served in the game room and kitchen only. Dream Dealers will be providing the bartenders to assure proper dispensing. Those attending will be permitted in the game room, kitchen and outside patio (temperature permitting) only. The diagram showing the location and home is below. The home also has cameras for additional monitoring. Attendees will be bused in as to not cause blocking of the road.
