10 **AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY,**
11 **ARIZONA, AMENDING ARTICLE 8-3, SANITATION;**
12 **SECTIONS 8-3-6, VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS; 8-3-7,**
13 **RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION; SERVICES; AND 8-3-9,**
14 **FREQUENCY OF COLLECTION; HOURS**
15

16 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF**
17 **PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA:**
18

19 Section 1. The Town of Paradise Valley’s Code is hereby amended as follows,
20 showing text to be added in **bold** and deleting the text shown by ~~strikeout~~.

22 Section 8-3-6 VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS:
23

24 A. All vehicles used for refuse collection within the Town must be inspected and provide
25 certification that they meet the following minimum requirements:
26

- 27 (1) ~~All vehicles~~ **Vehicles** must be in good condition and repair. The bodies shall
28 be of readily cleanable construction, watertight and metal-lined to the full
29 width and height of the body, with all seams welded.
- 30 (2) Vehicles shall be maintained and operated in a clean and neat manner so as to
31 prevent refuse from spilling, leaking and blowing. All vehicles shall have
32 enclosed bodies. Where spillage does occur, is shall be picked up immediately
33 by the collector and returned to the vehicle or container.
- 34 (3) The outside of each vehicle must be clearly identified by the name and
35 telephone number of the contractor operating the vehicle.
- 36 (4) Any open-top roll off container must have a cover that prevents refuse or
37 contents from spilling or flowing onto the roadway.
- 38 (5) **[Option A:] Vehicles with diesel engines shall be no older than 2010 nor**
39 **older than seven (7) years.; or**
40 **[Option B:] Vehicles with diesel engines shall be no older than 2007.**
41 **Commencing January 1, 2020, vehicles shall be no older than 2010.**
42 **Commencing January 1, 2030, vehicles shall be no older than 2020.**
- 43 (6) **Vehicle fleet is required to have “operation-at-idle” and “smart back up”**
44 **technology.**

46 B. Unless there is a specific need for other types of collection equipment, all residential
47 solid waste and recyclable collection vehicles shall be of the automated side loading
48 design, intended to service 60 to 100 gallon wheeled containers. **All licensees shall**
49 **provide containers that are free of noticeable defects and in good working order,**

1 **including a lid that prevents rainwater from entering the container and a fully**
2 **functioning hinge.**

4 Section 8-3-7 RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION; SERVICES

5 A. The contractor shall collect solid waste and recyclable materials from
6 residences in accordance with the provisions of this Article.

7 ~~The contractor shall offer to all customers twice per week collection of solid waste~~
8 ~~and at least semi-monthly collection of recyclables. The Town may at its option,~~
9 **Contractors may** make application to appropriate state and/or Maricopa County
10 agency for a waiver of twice weekly solid waste collection for areas in which
11 recyclables are collected weekly, such that solid waste and recyclables will each be
12 collected once weekly, **however, contractors may continue to offer twice a week**
13 **collection of solid waste and weekly collection of recyclables.**Section 8-3-9

14 FREQUENCY OF COLLECTION; HOURS

15 A. The frequency of solid waste collection shall be in accordance with the
16 regulations of the state or county agency with jurisdiction.

17 ~~Collection-Residential~~ collection, **including recyclables, for those residences south of**
18 **Lincoln Drive and west of Tatum Boulevard** is allowed ~~on weekdays only on Tuesdays~~
19 **and Fridays** from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. **Residential collection, including recyclables,**
20 **for those residences north of Lincoln Drive and east of Tatum Boulevard is allowed on**
21 **Mondays and Thursdays from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.** Commercial waste removal
22 service is also allowed on weekends and holidays. The Town reserves the right to further
23 regulate days of collection to achieve more efficient service routing within the Town.
24 Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance
25 or any part of these amendments to the Town Code adopted herein by reference is for any
26 reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent
27 jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

28 Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective February 1, 2017 .
