Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Adoption of Resolution Number 2024-19; Approving the Canvass of Election for the General Election Held on November 5, 2024

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution 2024-19.

SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Arizona law (ARS § 16-642) requires the Town Council meet and canvass the election not less than six days nor more than twenty days following the election. The attached resolution certifies the election results, declares the winners, and serves as a permanent public record of the canvass.

A total of 7,707 valid ballots were cast in the General Election held on November 5, 2024 for the runoff election for Paradise Valley mayor. Voter turnout equaled 89.87%, which is record turnout for a Town election. Attached Resolution 2024-19 serves as the official canvass of the election. It documents the number of ballots cast and votes received by each candidate by precinct.

The final results show that Mark Stanton received a majority of the total votes cast for mayor and will be issued a certificate of election.

The new Mayor and Town Council term will begin January 9, 2025.
