AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA; AMENDING CHAPTER 5 <u>BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION</u> INCLUDING ARTICLE 5-1, <u>BUILDING CODE</u>; ARTICLE 5-2, <u>RESIDENTIAL CODE</u>; ARTICLE 5-3, <u>NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE</u>; ARTICLE 5-4, <u>MECHANICAL CODE</u>; ARTICLE 5-5 <u>PLUMBING CODE</u>; ARTICLE 5-6, <u>PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE</u>; ARTICLE 5-7, <u>FUEL GAS CODE</u> AND ARTICLE 5-9, <u>ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE</u>.
