Changes from Recommended to Tentative Budget p.181

Add revenue and expenditures of \$50,000 to PD overtime for DUI (\$25k) and STEP (25K) grants in patrol. [This is AEL exempt.](#)

Reduce expenditures for 3rd party plan review and inspection costs of \$40,200 (\$3,350 per month); services covered by recommended new Engineering Technician position.

Add expenditures of \$20,000 in CDD for census 2020 outreach.

Add revenue and expenditures for PSPRS payment of the Unfunded Liability and potential proceeds. [This is AEL exempt.](#)

CIP 3rd Party services *for construction management - roadway improvement for 5-star projects* ~~to update all future year costs~~; \$300,000

Add expenditures of \$5,000 for Legislative outreach.



May 23rd (modified schedule)

Tentative Budget Adoption:

Resolution & AZ State forms; sets the maximum; public posting

Purchase approvals in June, contingent on 2020 appropriations

PD Vehicles have lead time;
Has been common practice

Budget amendments for 2019:

Draft resolution in the FY2020 Recommended Budget (p. 191)

Plus: *Increase Community Development professional services budget by \$65,000 for 3rd party inspections that is managed by the Town and reimbursed by the property owner. (Five Star)*
