

Proclamation

WHEREAS by the issuance of this proclamation the Town of Paradise Valley hereby recognizes Christ Church of the Ascension at 4015 East Lincoln Drive, as an official historic property; and

WHEREAS on November 1st, 2018, the Town of Paradise Valley and the Historical Advisory Committee established the Historic Property Recognition Program that allows property owners to voluntarily submit their property for consideration if it meets the requirements of the program; and

WHEREAS the property at 4015 East Lincoln Drive, Christ Church of the Ascension, was designed by Benny Gonzales and built in 1967 in a Spanish revival style using regionally inspired materials, and features a cohesive campus with open courtyards, circulation paths, and a Memorial Garden in which the remains of Peggy and Senator Barry Goldwater are interred; and

WHEREAS this property exemplifies the beauty of the Town and maintains the values that the Town has exemplified since its founding in 1961.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark Stanton, Mayor of the Town of Paradise Valley, do hereby proclaim the property located at 4015 East Lincoln Drive as part of the

"HISTORIC PROPERTY RECOGNITION PROGRAM"


