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1 McDonald Drive for a distance of seven hundred (700) feet.

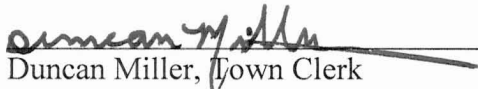
