Residential Parking Permit Zones

- History
 - Requested by Town Staff in 2015
 - Address neighborhood near Echo Canyon
 - Ordinance 688 passed 7-0 on June 11, 2015
 - To be reviewed one year after implementation
 - Ordinance slated to sunset on July 1, 2017
 - Zero Residential Parking Permits requested since Ordinance 688 implemented



Residential Parking Permit Zones

- Town Manager designates areas where parking is restricted to parking permit holders
- Council must approve such areas
- Police Chief makes a finding that area is significantly impacted by illegally parked vehicles not owned by residents
- Police Department issues permits to residents for street parking
 - Three permits per residence



Residential Parking Permits

- Only owner of residences can apply for parking permits
 - May not be sold or leased by resident owner
 - May be placed in guest's vehicles
- Permits are valid for 12 months
- Permits must be clearly visible on driver side dashboard
- Exception for marked service and delivery vehicles
