BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT ROLE

- Board of Adjustment is a Quasi-Judicial Body that:
 - Hears and decides variances from Zoning
 Ordinance based on specific state
 mandated criteria
 - Hears and decides appeals from decisions of Zoning Administrator

THE FOLLOWING CODE REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET FOR THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT TO GRANT A VARIANCE (BASED UPON STATE STATUTE AND TOWN CODE). PLEASE PROVIDE EVIDENCE TO SATISFY THE CONDITIONS BELOW.

 "That there are special circumstances applicable to the property, which may include circumstances related to the property's size, shape, topography, location, or surroundings; and" (Town Code Section 2-5-3(C)4).

"That the special circumstances applicable to the property were not self-imposed or created by the property owner; and" (Town Code Section 2-5-3(C)4).

 "That the strict application of the Zoning Ordinance will deprive the property of privileges enjoyed by other property of the same classification in the same zoning district" (Town Code Section 2-5-3(C)4).

Please note that the Board of Adjustment cannot grant variances that will make any changes in the uses permitted in any zoning classification or zoning district or that will constitute a grant of special privileges inconsistent with the limitations upon other properties in the vicinity and zoning district in which such property is located (Town Code Section 2-5-3(C)4).



BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT MEMBERS

- 7 volunteer members
- Appointed by Town Council
- Serve a staggered three-year term
- Elect Chair each April by majority vote of Board




PROCESS

- 2 to 3 Month Process
- Pre-application Review by Staff
- Application Submittal
 - Staff review to deem complete
 - Noticing in newspaper
 - Posting on site
 - Noticing of property owners within 1,500' radius
- Public Hearing



 Board may deny, approve as submitted, approve with conditions, or continue



PROCEDURES

BOA Handbook Adopted February 2, 2023

- Consistent with State Law criteria for variances
- Outlines expectations of members
- Code of conduct
- Chairman's script to clarify Board role for residents attending meetings
