August 5 - first day back to school (teaching staff only)
August 13 - first day of preschool for students
The school year will end in mid-May, the exact date is TBD

Our school week is M-F.
We have 6 classes of children in attendance Monday-Wednesday. On Thursday we have 5 classes in attendance, and on Fridays we have only 4 classes.

The majority of our students are on campus from
9:00am (main drop off time) until 12:00noon (main pick up time).

Monday-Wednesday, we have roughly 100 students on campus between 9:00am-noon.
On Thursdays and Fridays, we typically have about 80 students on campus between 9:00am-noon.
A small portion of our enrollment arrives early - 8:00am and anytime after. Typically no more than 20 children.
A small portion of our enrollment stays for lunch bunch, our after school program. This runs from noon until 2:30pm.
Typically there are no more than 30 children on campus between noon and 2:30pm.

We close for most school holidays, including a week in October for Fall Break as well as three days away at Thanksgiving.
We have approximately two weeks off surrounding Christmas Break, and a Spring Break in March.
