**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA,
RELATING TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENTS; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE
TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY'S EXECUTION OF THE
ARIZONA MUTUAL AID COMPACT, A MULTIPARTY
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY AND
MILITARY AFFAIRS AND PARTICIPATING COUNTIES,
CITIES, TOWNS, TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS AND FIRE
DISTRICTS STATEWIDE**

17 WHEREAS, the Arizona Mutual Aid Compact, a multiparty intergovernmental
18 agreement between the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs and
19 participating counties, cities, towns, tribal governments and fire districts statewide,
20 assures that Arizona's various jurisdictions, when faced with an emergency incident that
21 may exceed a single jurisdiction's ability to mitigate alone, can quickly and efficiently
22 request, provide and be reimbursed for mutual aid in an orderly fashion using procedures
23 that they all understand and have agreed to in advance; and

24 WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley desires to become a signatory to the
25 Arizona Mutual Aid Compact.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

27 1. The Arizona Mutual Aid Compact, a multiparty intergovernmental
28 agreement between the Town of Paradise Valley, the Arizona Department of Emergency
29 and Military Affairs and other signatory counties, cities, towns, tribal governments and
30 fire districts statewide, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is approved.

31 2. The Town Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Arizona
Mutual Aid Compact on behalf of the Town of Paradise Valley and the Town Clerk is

1 authorized and directed to attest the same.

2 3. The various Town officers and employees are authorized and directed to
3 perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this resolution.

4 4. The Town’s participation in the Arizona Mutual Aid Compact is valid for
5 ten years and will need to be reapproved by the Council during 2030.

6 5. That an emergency is declared to exist and all orders or resolutions in
7 conflict shall be, and the same are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, and
8 that this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

9 PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Council of the TOWN OF
10 PARADISE VALLEY, Arizona, this 9th day of April, 2020.
