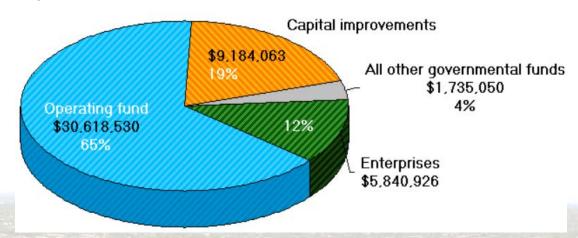
- Overview (comparisons to FY18 Budget)
  - The Good
    - Operating Revenues are up 11.9%
    - Total Expenditures are down 10%
    - Public Safety Pension to be paid down another \$5-6M
    - Robust Capital Improvement Program of \$9.2 M
    - MPC Debt Paid Off
    - Operating Reserve at 104% of Current Year
    - Health Benefits Cost Flat



- Overview (cont.)
  - The Challenging
    - Workload Up = Request for 8.7 new FTE
    - Expenditure Limit Near Max (expected)
    - Lincoln Mill & Overlay Delayed 1 year
    - Technology Hitting End of Life (ex. Body Cameras)
    - Labor Inflation (4%)

  - 1 FT Court Clerk (eliminate 3 PT temp)

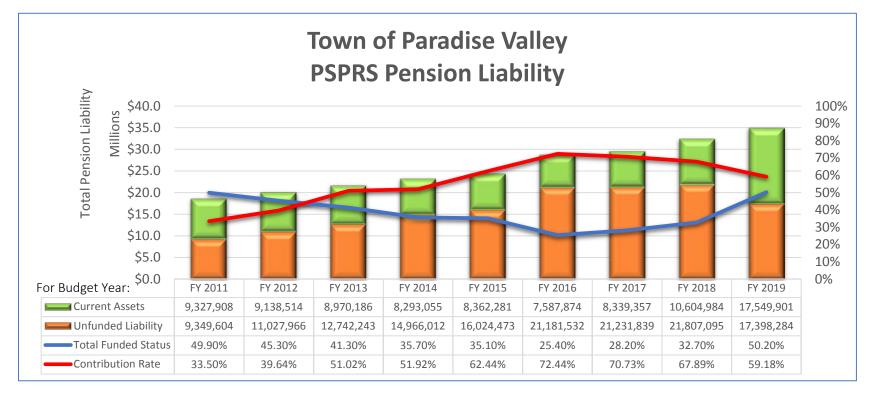


- Recommended Positions (others)
  - 0.7 Assistant Town Attorney (eliminate 0.5 PT Temp)
  - 1.0 Engineering Technician/Hillside
  - 1.0 GIS Technician

    - Court
    - Alarm
  - Pension Continue to reduce unfunded liability

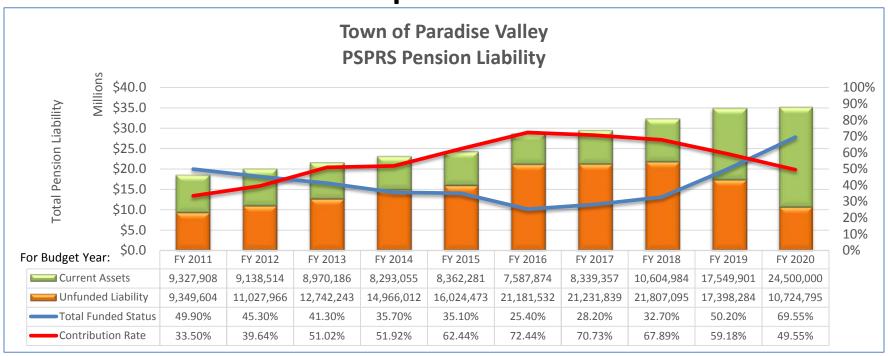




- Significant positive impacts from recent Council actions

  - Unfunded liability and corresponding contribution rate decreasing
