ORDER

On April 12, 2017, this matter came before the Board of Adjustment on an appeal of the Zoning Administrator's November 29, 2016 decision regarding enforcement of the Town of Paradise Valley Zoning Ordinance allowing the TMS Ventures, LLC Hillside Building Committee application (Case No. 16-280) ("TMS Application") for the Property assigned Maricopa County Assessor's Parcel No. 172-47-078D (the "TMS Property") to be processed "at risk," with the issuance of a building permit or other construction permits contingent on the outcome of pending litigation regarding legal access to the TMS Property (hereinafter the "ZA Decision").
