Extra Work to Complete Tatum/McDonald Work

Al, at our earlier meeting we said that we needed to do one more change order or letter agreement primarily to cover grouted riprap. After further review of the issues, we have decided to use dumped riprap for which there is a bid item, but there is still some additional work that needs to be addressed to complete this project. The following is a list with my estimate of the cost of each item. I seek your concurrence before proceeding.

VAsphalt Repair to Pensmith's Driveway – This is a segment of old Tatum Boulevard which was abandoned and turned into a private drive following realignment of the road. There is a defective area in the middle of the driveway which desperately needs to be repaired. This was a pre-existing condition. Estimated cost \$3,800

Site Preparation for Additional Dumped Riprap - Two Locations including the Holliman property adjacent to Royey Avenue cul-de-sac and headwall for pipe run 20 at Sta. 25+24. Estimated cost of the additional work to prepare the site \$1,500.

Additional Grading for Riprap Placement at the Drain Inlet for Pipe 17 - The headwall and inlet is detailed to have riprap, but the slope is too steep and it is not possible to flatten the slope beyond a 1:1 due to the adjacent block wall. Therefore, additional hand grading and hand placing of riprap is required. We estimate the additional cost to be \$750 for grading and \$750 for hand placing riprap for a total estimated additional cost of \$1,500.

Water Valve on Tatum – does not have a riser which means we have to dig down to the valve and install a riser. The best way to do this would be a soft dig which would limit the size of the excavation. We estimate that this will cost an additional \$750.

Replacement of Palo Verde Tree - The Home Owners Association adjacent to Tatum is insisting that we replace a Palo Verde in the right of way. They insist that Archon was responsible for removing the Palo Verde when installing interconnect conduit. I recommend that we replace the Palo Verde for an estimated cost of \$500. There is some additional landscaping to be done in this area, but we are requiring Sage to undertake that work at no additional cost. Estimated Cost \$500

Based on the above, the total estimated cost for extra work is \$8,050.

Al, before proceeding I seek your concurrence that it is acceptable to incur this additional cost in the estimated amounts. If you agree, it can be done as either a letter agreement since it is under \$10,000 or a change order. If you prefer the change order we will formally prepare the CRN and submit it for your approval. Sage's contractor wants more money than I am recommending and may resist proceeding in any case, but if you concur with the above I will proceed to negotiate with them.



1. INTRODUCTION

This proposal presents a scope of services for ITS Engineers & Constructors to engineer, furnish, install, integrate and test a CCTV camera system at the intersection of Tatum & McDonald. The proposal also presents a scope of work to establish a fiber optic communications link from the Paradise Valley Municipal Complex to the intersections of Tatum & Lincoln and of Tatum & McDonald for traffic signal controller communication.

This proposal includes two optional items:

- Furnishing and installing one Camera Cameleon Workstation with a quad video display. Camera Cameleon licensing would be arranged through the ADOT statewide Camera Cameleon license at no cost to the City.
- Furnishing and installing communications equipment for traffic signal communications to the traffic signal controllers at the intersections of Tatum & Lincoln and Tatum & McDonald.

2. BACKGROUND

A recent project to realign the intersection of Tatum & McDonald required the contractor to dismantle and remove the CCTV camera installation that previously existed at the intersection. The Paradise Valley Police Department would like to have the camera re-installed to resume observation of traffic conditions in the area. Paradise Valley Public Works would also like to have traffic signal communications established between the intersections of Tatum & Lincoln and Tatum & McDonald as well.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

Task 1: Furnish and Install Fiber Optic Cable

Objectives: Provide a functional fiber optic communication link.

Deliverables: A functional fiber optic communication link.

The work necessary to complete the fiber optic cable installation consists of the following:

- Coordination with the Paradise Valley Public Works Department to gain access to Paradise Valley facilities.
- Furnish and install a new 12 strand fiber optic cable, in conduit installed by others, continuous from the splice location at the intersection of Tatum & Lincoln to the traffic signal cabinet at Tatum & McDonald.
