RESOLUTION NUMBER 2016-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council established, an Advisory Committee on Public Safety (the "Committee") by Resolution Number 1330 on March 26, 2015 to preserve and improve the quality of life of Paradise Valley by assisting the Police Department and Community Resource Officer in engaging the community in a public dialogue on issues relevant to public safety, including prevention, enforcement, awareness and community/victim outreach; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 1330 placed a one-year review and renewal requirement on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council received an update on the Committee's activities and accomplishments on May 12, 2016 and discussed the Committee's reauthorization on May 26, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council believe it is in the best interest of the Town of Paradise Valley for the Committee to continue with its mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Advisory Committee on Public Safety is hereby reauthorized.

- A. The mission, duties, and membership provisions of Resolution Number 1330 shall remain unchanged.
- B. The Committee shall be subject to review and renewal by the Mayor and Council before July 1, 2017.
