#### **ORDINANCE NUMBER 2016-05**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY. ARTICLE 2, MAYOR ARIZONA, AMENDING AND **COUNCIL**; **SECTIONS COMMITEES AND** 2-5-1, COMMISSIONS IN **GENERAL**: 2-5-2, **PLANNING COMMISION; AND 2-5-3, BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT** 

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Town of Paradise Valley's Code is hereby amended as follows, showing text to be added in **bold** and deleting the text shown by <u>strikeout</u>.

## Section 2-5-1 Committees and Commissions in General

A. The Council may create such committees, commissions or boards, standing or special, as it deems necessary. They shall consist of as many members and shall perform such duties as the Council may require and shall exist at the pleasure of the Council. All members of such committees, commissions or boards shall serve at the pleasure of the Council. In the event that the term of a member of a committee, commission, or board has expired, the member whose term has expired shall continue to serve until a successor has been appointed and qualified to fill that member's seat. In the event of a vacancy occurring on any committee, commission, or board due to resignation, death, or disqualification from office, the member appointed to fill the vacant committee, commission, or board seat shall only fill such vacancy for the unexpired term of the vacated seat.

### Section 2-5-2 Planning Commission

A. Creation and Membership. The Planning Commission as previously established is hereby continued in full force and effect, and there is established herewith a Planning Commission which shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall be appointed for a term of three years. The Planning Commission as created herewith may be referred to as the Zoning Commission or the Planning and Zoning Commission. Members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Town Council. All persons seeking to be appointed or re-appointed to a term on the Planning Commission shall file a written application for such appointment or re-appointment with the Mayor on or before the date set by the Town of the year that the term subject to appointment would become vacant. However, this written application requirement does not apply to an appointment to serve the balance of a term which has become vacant prior to the expiration of the term. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place has become vacant. The Planning Commission shall, at its first meeting in October April of each year, elect one of its members to serve as its Chairman-

designate. The member designated to be Chairman shall be approved or disapproved for the Chairmanship by the Town Council within thirty (30) days of the election by the Commission. If the Chairman-designate is approved for the Chairmanship by the Town Council, he shall become the Chairman immediately upon such approval, and he shall serve as Chairman of the Commission (1) until a successor as Chairman is elected and approved in the following year, or (2) until the Chairmanship shall, for any reason, become vacant. If the Chairman-designate is disapproved for the Chairmanship by the Town Council, the Planning Commission shall, at its next meeting after such Council disapproval, elect another one of its members to serve as its Chairman-designate, and the member so designated shall be approved and become the Chairman or be disapproved pursuant to the procedures described herein. If, for any reason, the position of Chairman becomes vacant, then the Commission, at its next meeting after such position becomes vacant, shall elect a Chairman-designate for the remainder of the term, and the member so designated shall be approved and become the Chairman or be disapproved pursuant to the procedures prescribed herein. No member shall serve as Chairman of the Commission for a period of time in excess of two (2) consecutive terms.

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### Board of Adjustment

21 Creation and Membership. The Board of Adjustment as previously established is A. 22 hereby continued in full force and effect, and there is established herewith a Board of 23 Adjustment which shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall be appointed 24 for a term of three years. The word "Board" when used in this article shall mean the 25 Board of Adjustment. Members of said Board shall be appointed by the Mayor 26 subject to confirmation by majority vote of the Town Council. All persons seeking 27 to be appointed or re-appointed to a term on the Board of Adjustment shall file a 28 written application for such appointment or re-appointment with the Mayor on or 29 before August 15 of the year the date set by the Town of the year that the term 30 subject to appointment would become vacant. However, this written application 31 requirement does not apply to an appointment to serve the balance of a term which 32 has become vacant prior to the expiration of the term. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place has become vacant. The Board of 33 34 Adjustment shall, at its first meeting in October April of each year, elect one of its 35 members to serve as its Chairman-designate. The member designated to be Chairman shall be approved or disapproved for the Chairmanship by the Town 36 37 Council within thirty (30) days of the election of the Board of Adjustment. If the 38 Chairman-designate is approved for the Chairmanship by the Town Council, he shall 39 become the Chairman immediately upon such approval, and he shall serve as 40 Chairman of the Board (1) until a successor as Chairman is elected and approved in the following year, or (2) until the Chairmanship shall, for any reason, become 41 vacant. If the Chairman-designate is disapproved for the Chairmanship by the Town 42 Council, the Board of Adjustment shall, at its next meeting after such Council 43 44 disapproval, elect another one of its members to serve as its Chairman designate, and 45 the member so designated shall be approved and become the Chairman or be disapproved pursuant to the procedures described herein. If, for any reason, the 46 47 position of Chairman becomes

<u>Section 2</u> . If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments to the Town Code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.	
Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective in the manner provided by law.
