A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA, REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT ON A SEVEN HUNDRED (700) FOOT PORTION OF INVERGORDON ROAD IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH MACDONALD DRIVE IN THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

<u>Sec. 1</u>. WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley has determined the following as a result of engineering and traffic investigation:

- Invergordon Road is a two lane north and south bound roadway that carries a heavy volume of traffic between, on the south, MacDonald Drive, and, on the north, Lincoln Drive; and
- 2. There are four-way stop sign traffic controls at the intersection of Invergordon Road and MacDonald Drive; and
- 3. The school and church located on Invergordon Road within seven hundred (700) feet of the north right-of-way line for MacDonald Drive increase traffic congestion, and excessive speed produces hazards for children walking along Invergordon Road to and from the school; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. 28-703 authorizes a Town to determine and declare reasonable and safe maximum speed limits for streets within the Town, and

WHEREAS, Section 11-2-1 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Paradise Valley authorizes the Town Council to change the speed limit on specified streets by resolution,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Paradise Valley that the maximum speed limit on that portion of Invergordon Road between MacDonald Drive and a point seven hundred (700) feet north of the north right-of-way line of

MacDonald Drive, in the Town of Paradise Valley, is hereby determined and declared to be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

Sec. 2. WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Arizona, and approval by the Mayor.
