RESOLUTION NO. 472

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA, DECLARING A REASONABLE AND SAFE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MILES PER HOUR ON INVERGORDON ROAD BETWEEN EAST LINCOLN DRIVE AND CHAPARRAL ROAD, EXCEPT FOR A PORTION 700 FEET LONG IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF MacDONALD DRIVE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Paradise Valley has determined as a result of a traffic and engineering investigation that a thirty-five (35) mile per hour speed limit is a reasonable and safe maximum speed limit on Invergordon Road between East Lincoln Drive and Chaparral Road except for that part lying immediately north of the northern right-of-way of MacDonald Drive for a distance of 700 feet, for which a safe speed of twenty-five (25) miles per hour has been established (Resolution No. 227);

WHEREAS, A.R.S. 28-703 authorizes the Town to determine and declare reasonable and safe maximum speed limits for streets within the Town;

WHEREAS, Section 11-2-1 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Paradise Valley authorizes the Town Council to change the speed limit on specified streets by resolution;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley that the reasonable and safe maximum speed limit on Invergordon Road between East Lincoln Drive and Chaparral Road except for that part lying immediately north of the northern right-of-way of MacDonald Drive for a distance of 700 feet, is determined and declared to be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Arizona.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Paradise Valley, Arizona, on this 25th day of April, 1985.


