13) Requests for Future Agenda Items - Requests for future agenda items are topics or issues of interest that at least four-three Council Members would like to have considered for discussion at a future meeting. Any member of the Council may move to have the Town Manager add a new agenda item to a future-the-next-meeting-or-a-specific agenda. Upon the concurrence of three-two more Members, which may include the Mayor, the item shall be added to the next-meeting-by-the-motion-or-a-list-of-future-agenda-items-hall be added to the next-meeting-by-the-motion-or-a-list-of-future-agenda-item within sixty days. In the event that the Town Manager determines such a future agenda item request should be moved to a later date due to the need for the Council to address more critical agenda items, the Town Manager next-meeting-may-move-the-item-to-move-the-item-to-a-later Council Meeting-date, but only to the next scheduled Council Meeting date. Any discussion on the motion to add a future agenda item shall be limited to the propriety of placing such item on a future agenda and not on the merits of such agenda item.
