

13) Requests for Future Agenda Items - Requests for future agenda items are topics or issues of interest that at least ~~four~~three Council Members would like to have considered for discussion at a future meeting. Any member of the Council may move to have the Town Manager add a new agenda item to ~~a future~~the next meeting or a specific agenda. Upon the concurrence of ~~three~~two more Members, which may include the Mayor, the item shall be added to the next meeting by the motion or a list of future agenda items and scheduled by the Town Manager as a future agenda item within sixty days. In the event that the Town Manager determines such a future agenda item request should be moved to a later date due to the need for the Council to address more critical agenda items, the Town Manager ~~may move the requested~~needs the approval of the three Council members who voted for the item to move the item to a later Council Meeting date, but only to the next scheduled Council Meeting date. Any discussion on the motion to add a future agenda item shall be limited to the propriety of placing such item on a future agenda and not on the merits of such agenda item.
