ACOPS History

- On March 26th, 2015, the Paradise Valley Town Council voted to approve Resolution 1330, which created the Advisory Committee on Public Safety.
- On June 25, 2015, the ACOPS group met for the first time.
- Met seven times during FY 16.



Annual Review

- Resolution 1330
 - Requires annual review by Town Council
 - May 12, 2016 annual report to Town Council
 - May 26, 2016 study session to review ACOPS
- Renewed for one year in June 2016
- Resolution 2017-21 revising Resolution 1330
 - Removing annual review of ACOPS by Town Council
 - Governing ACOPS under Town Code 2-5-1



Advisory Committee on Public Safety Goals

- Promoting resident participation and engagement; including reviews and updates of the strategic plan.
- Engaging the community on public safety issues.
- Receiving presentations and materials from the Paradise Valley Police Department.
- Advise the Mayor and Council on Committee activities and recommendations.



Advisory Committee on Public Safety Goals

- ACOPS, led by a member of Council with engagement by the Chief and the Community Resource Officer has been successfully fulfilling this mission.



Ongoing Activities

- Floor plan project
 - ACOPS recognized the need to proactively communicate with our schools, resorts and places of worship in order to secure floor plans.
 - ACOPS members each contacted places of worship to gather this important information to give to PVPD for compilation in case of emergency.



Ongoing Activities

- Construction Safety
 - Reducing construction site theft
 - Decreasing neighborhood impact
 - Best practices sheets
- False Alarm Reduction
 - Research other ordinances
 - Research reduction programs
 - Determine effectiveness for Paradise Valley
