NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA THAT:
Managerial and minor amendments for schools, government buildings, and places of
worship shall also be based on 50% of the cost recovery model.
