

PROJECT NARRATIVE 8002 N 47th St PV

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This house was constructed in 1976 out of 8" - 12" masonary block, frame interior walls, with a red tile roof on Lots 64 and 65 in Tatum Canyon. The original driveway was constructed on Lot 65 and abandoned in 2005. A new driveway to this house was built on Lot 66 in 2005.

I would like to built a 16' wide driveway back on Lot 65 (where it was previously located).

All of the windows and glass containing doors, with the exception of some windows on the northeast side of the house are single pane. The entry to the house, the west and north interior covers courtyard walkway and the exterior covered south patio have arches. There has been extensive termite damage to the interior stud framed walls. The current 600 amp panel wiring has been damaged by rats and needs to be replaced by a new 400 amp panel.

I would like to:

Replace the red tile roof with a black standing seam metal roof; (at the same time repairing any roof underlay damage)

Replace the existing single pane windows and doors with energy efficient dual pane windows and doors . Square off all arches

Replace/ repair as necessary, all interior walls;

Install new a/c, water heaters, cabinets, flooring , lights - led , bathroom fixtures , garage doors , as needed .

No exterior walls are affected, except for the elimination of the arches and the addition of a guest powder room by front door, within the existing, under roof area.

Repair the existing pool, add a spa, new eqpt; cut down the solid block wall by approx 2', surrounding the pool area on the south end, creating a "view fence".

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
