CALL FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Room 310, Yavapai County Administrative Services Building, 1015 Fair Street, Prescott, Arizona until 1:30 p.m. (by the official clock located in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors), February 28, 2012 for the CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF OR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND LIGHTING FOR YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, CONTRACT #111201, in strict accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Fleet Management, Prescott, Arizona. No bids will be accepted after 1:30 p.m. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:00 p.m. on February 28, 2012.

There will be a mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting scheduled for 9:00a.m., February 14, 2012 in the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department Conference Room, located at 1100 Commerce Drive, Prescott, Arizona. Any questions or concerns about the bid will be addressed at that time.

Qualified bidders must be identified on the Bid Holders List maintained in the office of Yavapai County Fleet Management. Specifications and contract documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the Fleet Management Department, 1100 Commerce Drive, Prescott, Arizona 86305, telephone 928.771.3160. All proposals shall be made on the bid proposal forms prepared by Yavapai County as part of the contract documents and shall include all applicable taxes.

Each proposal submitted, either by hand, U.S. Postal Service, or other carrier, shall be sealed and plainly marked "BID FOR THE PURCHASE OF OR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND LIGHTING FOR YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, CONTRACT #111201," All proposals shall be mailed or delivered to the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors, 1015 Fair Street, Room 310, Prescott, Arizona 86305. Yavapai County will not be responsible for those bids submitted that are not marked appropriately and/or sent to the wrong address.

Bidders are invited to be present at the opening of bids, but absence will not be considered cause for disqualification.

Bidders shall be responsible for any licenses or permits required by the regulatory agency of the State of Arizona that apply to the performance of this contract.

The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities, and to accept the bid deemed to be in the best interest of Yavapai County.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

I. PREPARATION OF BIDS:

- A. All information requested of the bidder(s) shall be entered as specified in the appropriate space on the forms prepared by Yavapai County as part of the Contract Documents. The Bid Packet shall contain the Bid Proposal and any addendum acknowledgments. Failure to do so may disqualify the bid.
- B. All information shall be entered in ink or typewritten. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections inserted before submission of the bid. Corrections shall be initialed in ink by the person signing the bid.
- C. Corrections and/or modifications received after the closing time specified will not be accepted.
- D. Time of delivery shall be stated as the number of calendar days or number of hours following receipt of the order by the bidder to receipt of the goods or services by the County.
- E. All bids shall be signed by an authorized officer or authorized employee of the bidder.
- F. Bids must be submitted by the date and prior to the time specified in the Call for Bids to be considered. No late bids, telegraphic or telephone bids will be accepted.
- G. To allow for an adequate evaluation, Yavapai County requires the bidder(s) proposal offer in response to this Request for Proposal to be valid and irrevocable for sixty (60) days after the day of bid opening.
- H. Bidder(s) are to provide one (1) original and one (1) extra hard copy.
- I. Bidder(s) shall provide copies of its sales literature and brochures, and copies of any manufacturer's technical and descriptive literature regarding the material it proposes to provide. Literature shall be sufficient in detail to allow full and fair evaluation of the offer submitted, and must be included with the bid. Failure to include this information may result in the bid being rejected.
- J. Bidder(s) submitting proposals (bids) shall advise Yavapai County of all known order cut-off dates for the equipment/product specified in the Call for Bids at the time of submission. Notification of any subsequent date(s) (learned after submission) shall also be the responsibility of the bidder(s). The bidder(s) shall advise Yavapai County of subsequent cut-off dates by notifying the Fleet Management Department, in writing, of this new information.
- K. For reasons of clarity, all submissions of pricing shall be priced in the same unit (size, volume, quantity, weight, etc.) as the bid specifications request. Submissions (bids) failing to comply with this requirement may be declared non-responsive.
- L. Submit bids in a sealed envelope plainly marked with the bid title and closing date shown. Yavapai County will not be responsible for those bids submitted that are not marked appropriately and/or sent to the wrong address.

Inquiries may be submitted by telephone but must be followed up in writing. No oral communication is binding on Yavapai County.

II. BRAND NAMES:

- A. Brand names and numbers, when used, are for reference to indicate the character or quality desired. Whenever an article or material is defined by describing a proprietary product or by using the name of a manufacturer, the term "or equal" if not inserted shall be implied unless specified as "no exceptions". The specified article or material shall be understood as indicating type, function, minimum standard of design, efficiency and quality desired, and shall not be construed as to exclude any other manufactured products of comparable quality, design and efficiency.
- B. Equal items will be considered, provided the bid clearly describes the item. Bids for equal items shall state the brand and number or level of quality. The determination of the County as to what items are equal shall be final and conclusive.
- C. When the bidder(s) does not state brand, number or level of quality, it is understood that the bid is exactly as specified.
- D. The item(s) described in the specification shall be new, unused, manufacturer's latest improvements, unless specified otherwise. The item(s) bid shall include all standard materials and equipment, and shall include all items to provide functional and/or operational units. Item(s) modified or designed specifically to meet these specifications that are not normally standard items in the industry will not be considered. This does not preclude the changing of minor ingredients or components to those specified, so long as proper engineering and testing has occurred and documentation is furnished with the bid and Yavapai County is supplied with acceptable, fully functional and operational materials or equipment.

- E. All workmanship and materials shall be of good quality. All materials and equipment shall meet all applicable and current OSHA, EPA, Federal, Arizona State and industry regulations and standards in effect at delivery, no exceptions.
- F. Bidders shall be responsible for any and all licenses or permits required by the regulatory agency of the State of Arizona that apply to the performance of this contract.
- G. The item(s) bid shall meet or exceed these specifications. Compliance with or exception to the specification shall be indicated on the bid. Exceptions to these specifications noted by the bidder(s) will be subject to evaluation and consideration by Yavapai County as to quality, suitability, compatibility and design integrity in relation to the intended use.
- H. The evaluation of bids and the determination of acceptability of the supplies, equipment, materials, or services bid shall be at the sole responsibility of Yavapai County and will be based on information furnished by the bidder(s), or identified in the bid, as well as other information reasonably available to Yavapai County. The decision of acceptability made by Yavapai County shall be final.

III. SAMPLES:

A. Sample items, when requested, shall be furnished to Yavapai County free of cost of any sort. Samples of items selected may be retained for future comparison. Samples which are not destroyed by testing or which are not retained for future comparison will be returned upon request of the bidder.

IV. TAXES:

A. All bids shall include ALL APPLICABLE TAXES including but not limited to: Arizona Vendors-Transaction Privilege Tax; Out of State Vendors-Use Tax. Bid prices submitted shall not increase during the contract term due to tax increases.

V. LIABILITIES:

A. The bidder(s) shall hold Yavapai County, its officers, agents, servants and employees harmless from liability of any nature of any kind because of use of any copyrighted or un-copyrighted composition, secret process, patented or un-patented invention, articles or appliances furnished or used under this bid and agrees to indemnify Yavapai County at their own expense for any and all actions brought against Yavapai County because of the un-authorized use of such articles, composition, process, invention, items or appliances, including expert witness fees and attorney fees incurred by Yavapai County.

VI. DEFAULT BY BIDDER:

A. In case of default by the successful bidder(s), Yavapai County may procure the items or services from other sources and may deduct from any monies due or that may thereafter become due to the bidder(s) the difference between the prices named in any contract awarded pursuant to this Call for Bids or purchase order and the actual cost thereof to Yavapai County. Prices paid by Yavapai County shall be considered the prevailing market price at the time such purchase is made. Periods of performance may be extended if the facts as to the cause of delay justify such extension in the opinion of Yavapai County.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

VII. AWARDS:

A. Any contract(s) awarded pursuant to this Call for Bids will be awarded to the successful bidder(s) whose bid conforms to the invitation and whose bid is the most advantageous to Yavapai County concerning price, conformity to the specifications, and other factors, and as identified in the "Evaluation Criteria" worksheet. The Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County reserves the right to reject any or all bid(s), to waive formalities, and to accept the bid(s) deemed to be in the best interest of Yavapai County. Past performance on Yavapai County projects or other public projects will be evaluated in awarding such contracts and Yavapai County may decide to award to a bidder(s) who is not the low bidder(s). **DEVIATIONS FROM COUNTY SPECIFICATIONS MAY RESULT IN REJECTION OF BID.**

VIII. PAYMENT:

A. Contractor understands that Yavapai County has established an Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) program for all payments to providers of goods and services to the County and agrees to accept EFT payments in full satisfaction of the County's payment obligations pursuant to this Contract. Contractor further agrees to register for the County's EFT program within one month following the effective date of this Contract and understands that failure to comply with this registration requirement shall result in suspension of payments pursuant to this Contract until such time as the registration process is completed.

IX. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

A. Justification for termination of any contract(s) awarded pursuant to this Call for Bids shall include but not be limited to A.R.S. §38-511, workmanship, improper quality of material, insufficient workers, insufficient equipment, or budgetary limitations. Yavapai County may terminate or cancel such contracts at any time for any reason, with or without just cause. Additionally, failure on the part of the Vendor to meet the provisions of those sections of such contracts dealing with supply and/or delivery, start and completion of work, or complete installation procedures of traffic control where required shall be sufficient grounds on the part of Yavapai County to abandon, cancel or suspend the Contractor/Vendor's services at any time. The Contractor/Vendor shall be paid for those units satisfactorily supplied or installed at the unit price bid up to the time of cancellation. The Contractor/Vendor shall be given thirty (30) days written notice of termination. If termination of such contracts should occur, the Fleet Management Department may, at its option, recommend to the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors to award such contracts to the second lowest bidding Contractor/Vendor or select to re-advertise and re-bid the balance of such contracts, or select not to re-bid or award such contracts.

X. DELIVERY:

A. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to meet the delivery requirements of Yavapai County, as called for in the Technical Specifications. Yavapai County reserves the right to obtain equipment, materials or services on the open market in the event the vendor fails to make delivery, and any price differential will be charged against the vendor.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

XI. PRICES:

A. Prices given on this bid shall be effective for the duration of any contract awarded pursuant to this Call for Bids including any extensions thereof. Unit prices bid shall include all applicable taxes. Yavapai County does not guarantee any minimum or maximum amounts of purchase.

XII. PAYMENTS:

A. The accepted units, measured as provided herein, shall be paid for at the contract unit price.

XIII. GUARANTY:

A. The bidder(s) shall guarantee all work against any defects due to faulty materials or workmanship and replace same, at no cost to Yavapai County, upon verification of the faulty materials.

Proposals taking exception to the Special Terms and Conditions stated within this Request for Proposal may cause the Proposal to be considered nonresponsive and rejected.

- I. **CONTRACT TYPE:** Term with justifiable price adjustments allowed, indefinite quantity.
- II. CONTRACT LENGTH: The term of the Contract shall commence on the date of award and shall continue for a period of two (2) years thereafter, unless terminated, cancelled or extended as otherwise provided herein.
- III. CONTRACT RENEWAL: Yavapai County reserves the right to unilaterally extend the period of any resultant Contract for ninety (90) days beyond the stated term. In addition, Yavapai County at its option may renew for supplemental terms of up to a maximum of four (4) additional years. The period for any single renewal increment shall be determined by the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department. Such increment shall not be for more than a period of two (2) years each, unless Yavapai County is eligible to obtain a significant cost and/or supply advantage by a longer Contract renewal period.

IV. PRICING:

- A. Pricing accuracy and completeness are critical to the determination of an award. The Bidder(s) shall identify and price all items proposed.
- B. In the case of system proposals, the Bidder(s) shall identify all items that are required to make the system function in accordance with the stated specifications in this Request for Proposal.
- C. If provided pricing pages do not cover all such items, the Bidder(s) shall include an itemized list of all required products and services in the Proposal required for all system equipment to be fully functional and in conformity with the stated specifications stated in this Request for Proposal.

V. PRICE ADJUSTMENT:

A. After the Contract has been in effect for six (6) months Yavapai County Fleet Management will review documented requests for price increases. The price increase request documentation shall include any published manufacturer price sheets highlighted to indicate the price increase. The requested price increase must be based upon a cost increase that was clearly unforeseen at the time of the Proposal and can be shown to directly affect the price of the item concerned. Yavapai County Fleet Management will determine whether the requested price increase or an alternative option is in the best interest of Yavapai County.

- **B.** The Contractor is required to provide an advanced thirty (30) day written notification for any price increases. All price adjustments will be effective on the first day of the month following the approval by Yavapai County Fleet Management Department. After the County approves a price increase the Contactor shall not be eligible to receive an additional increase until six (6) months from the date of the last approved price increase.
- C. Price increase request must be acknowledged in writing by the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department before becoming effective. If the price increase request is not acknowledged within thirty (30) days, the Contractor shall contact the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department to insure the price increase request was received.
- **D.** The Contractor shall offer any published price reduction or if applicable to the Contract, profit sharing price advantage to Yavapai County concurrent with its announcement to other customers. A price reduction or profit sharing advantage may be offered at any time during the terms of the awarded Contract and shall become effective upon notice and acceptance. Yavapai County shall likewise take advantage of any special sales discounts offered to the general public, that exceed contracted price discounts extended to Yavapai County by the Contractor.

VI. EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- A. All equipment shall substantially meet the specification requirements. Exceptions to or deviations from the specifications will be evaluated and considered by Yavapai County. However, acceptance or rejection of such exceptions and/or deviations shall be at the sole discretion of Yavapai County, and Yavapai County's decision shall be final.
- B. All modifications and/or equipment installations must be made by the factory or by the vendor at the sole cost of the vendor. All such modifications or installations must be made to the manufacturer's specifications.
- C. All bids submitted shall show the name of manufacturer, the registered trade name and model number of the equipment proposed.

VII. DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE:

A. The Bidder(s) shall provide Yavapai County with complete manufacturers' descriptive literature regarding the materials, equipment, or products proposed to be furnished under the Contract. Literature shall be provided in sufficient detail so as to provide Yavapai County with full and fair evaluation of the proposal. Failure to include required information may result in the proposal being rejected.

VIII. CURRENT PRODUCTS:

A. All proposals made in response to this Request for Proposal shall be in current and ongoing production, shall have been formally announced for general marketing purposes, shall be a model or type currently functioning in user environments, and shall meet or exceed all specifications and requirements set forth in this solicitation. Enhancements to be established products need not necessarily comply, with this clause, and will be reviewed on individual merits.

IX. PRODUCT DISCONTINUANCE:

- A. Yavapai County may award contracts for particular products and/or models of equipment as a result of this solicitation. In the event that a product or model is discontinued by the manufacturer, Yavapai County at its sole discretion may allow the Contractor to provide a substitute for the discontinued item. The Contractor shall request permission by Yavapai County to substitute a new product or model and provide all of the following:
 - 1. A formal announcement from the manufacturer that the product or model has been discontinued;
 - 2. Documentation from the manufacturer that names the replacement product or model;
 - 3. Documentation that provides clear and convincing evidence that the replacement product or model meets or exceeds all specifications required by the original solicitation;
 - 4. Documentation that provides clear and convincing evidence that the replacement will be compatible with all of the functions or uses of the discontinued product or model; and
 - 5. Documentation confirming that the price for the replacement is the same or less that the discontinued product or model.

X. INSURANCE:

- A. Insurance required: Prior to commencing services under this Contract, the Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the Contract insurance against claims for injuries (including death) to persons and damage to property, which may arise from or in conjunction with the performance of the work hereunder by the Contractor, its agents, representatives, employees, subcontractors, or subsubcontractors. For bidder(s) with self-insurance, proof of self-insurance with minimum limits expressed below must be submitted on proper forms for evaluation prior to award of the Contract. A Contract Award Notice or Purchase Order will not be issued to a Vendor until receipt of all required insurance documents by the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department with such documents meeting all requirements herein. In addition, before any Contract renewal, all required insurance must be in force and on file with the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department. The Contractor must submit required insurance within ten (10) working days after the request by the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department or the award may be rescinded and another vendor selected for award.
- B. Minimum Limits of Coverage: Without limiting any obligations or liabilities, the Contractor, at its sole expense, shall purchase and maintain the minimum insurance specified below with companies duly licensed or otherwise approved by the State of Arizona, Department of Insurance and with forms satisfactory to Yavapai County. Each insurer shall have a current A.M. Best Company, Inc., rating of not less than A-. Use of alternative insurers requires prior approval from Yavapai County.

- 1. Minimum Limits of Insurance: The Contractor shall maintain limits no less than:
- a) Commercial General Liability:
 - (1) Commercial general liability insurance limit of not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence, with a \$2,000,000 general aggregate limit. The general aggregate limit shall apply separately to the services under this Contract or the general aggregate shall be twice the required per claim limit.
 - (2) The policy shall be primary and include coverage for the bodily injury, property damage, personal injury, products, completed operations, and blanket contractual coverage, including but not limited to the liability assumed under the indemnification provisions of this Contract which coverage will be at least as broad as insurance service officer policy form CG2010 11/85 edition or any replacement thereof.
 - (3) In the event the general liability policy is written on a "claims made" basis, coverage shall extend for two (2) years past the completion and acceptance of the services as evidenced by annual certificates of insurance.
 - (4) Such policy shall contain a "severability of interests" provision.
- b) Worker's Compensation:
 - (1) The Contractor shall carry worker's compensation insurance to cover obligations imposed by federal and state statutes having jurisdiction of Contractor employees engaged in the performance of services; and employer's liability insurance of not less than \$100,000 for each accident, \$100,000 disease for each employee and \$500,000 disease policy limit.
 - (2) In case services are subcontracted, the Contractor will require the subcontractor to provide worker's compensation and employer's liability to at least the same extent as provided by the Contactor.
- c) Automobile Liability:
 - (1) Commercial business automobile liability insurance with a combined single life or bodily injury and property damages of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident regarding any owned, hired, and non-owned vehicles assigned to or used in performance of the Contractor services. Coverage will be at least as broad as coverage Code 1 "any auto". Insurance Service Office policy form CA0001 Y87 or any replacements thereof. Such coverage shall include coverage for loading and unloading hazards.

C. Additional Insured:

1. The insurance coverage, except for worker's compensation and professional liability coverage, requires by this Contract, shall name Yavapai County, its agents, representatives, directors, officials, employees, and officers, as additional insured's, and shall specify that insurance afforded the Contractor shall be primary insurance, and that any insurance coverage carried by Yavapai County or its employees shall be excess coverage and not contributory coverage to that provided by Contactor.

D. Coverage Term:

1. All insurance required herein shall be maintained in full force and effect until all work or service required to be performed under the terms of the Contract is satisfactorily completed and formally accepted by Yavapai County. Failure to do so shall constitute a material breach of contract.

E. Primary Coverage:

1. Contractor's insurance shall be primary insurance to Yavapai County, and any insurance or self-insurance maintained by Yavapai County shall be excess of the Contractor's insurance and shall not contribute to it.

F. Claim Reporting:

1. Any failure to comply with the claim reporting provisions of the policies or any breach of a policy warranty shall not affect coverage under the policy to protect Yavapai County.

G. Waiver:

1. The policies, including worker's compensation, shall contain a waiver of transfer rights of recovery (subrogation) against Yavapai County, its agents, representatives, directors, officers, and employees for any claims arising out of the work or services of the Contractor.

H. Deductible/Retention:

1. The policies may provide coverage which contains deductibles or self-insured retentions. Such deductible and/or self-insured retentions shall not be applicable with respect to the coverage provided to Yavapai County under such policies. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for deductibles and/or self-insured retentions and Yavapai County, at its option may require the Contractor to secure the payment of such deductible or self-insured retentions by a surety bond or an irrevocable and unconditional letter of credit.

I. Certificates of Insurance:

- 1. Prior to commencing work or services under this Contract, the Contractor shall furnish the Yavapai County Fleet Management Department with certificates of insurance, or formal endorsements as required by the Contract, issued by the Contractor's insurer(s), as evidence that policies providing the required coverage, conditions, and limits required by this Contract are in full force and effect.
- 2. Such certificates shall identify this Contract number or name and shall provide for not less than thirty (30) days advance notice of cancellation, termination, or material alteration. Such certificates shall be sent directly to: Contract Administrator, Yavapai County Fleet Management, 1100 Commerce Drive, Prescott, AZ 86305.

J. Copies of Policies:

1. Yavapai County reserves the right to request and to receive, within ten (10) working days certified copies of any or all of the above policies and/or endorsements. Yavapai County shall not be obligated, however, to review same or to advise the Contractor of any deficiencies in such policies and endorsements, and such receipt shall not relieve the Contractor from, or be deemed a waiver of, Yavapai County's right to insist on strict fulfillment of the Contractor's obligations under this Contract.

XI. PAYMENTS AFTER ACCEPTANCE OF DELIVERY:

A. Payment in full shall be made to the Contractor within thirty (30) days after receipt and acceptance of delivery by Yavapai County, unless terms other than net thirty (30) are offered as a discount, at Yavapai County's sole discretion.

XII. CONDUCT AND DRESS CODE:

- A. The Contractor's employees shall maintain proper conduct at all times while on Yavapai County property. Employees shall respect other personnel at the work site. Abusive language, ethnic and racial slurs, sexual comments and jokes, shouting, and gestures toward other personnel will not be tolerated. Any occurrence will result in immediate action with possible dismissal of that employee from Yavapai County property.
- B. Employees will be neatly dressed with badges or uniforms that identify them as employees of the Contractor.
