Background

- May 31, 2018 TC Work Session:
- Consensus from TC regarding concepts and frame work of safety section:
 - Pre-application submittal shall be added to process,
 - Safety Improvement Plan (SIP) shall be submitted no later than formal hillside review submittal (earlier if applicant desires),
 - Construction Staging Plan (CSP) shall be part of building permit process (earlier if applicant desires),
 - Updates to blasting code are acceptable w/ edits, and
 - Hillside safety ordinance to cross reference reviewed hillside materials rather than re-create language.



Review Process

- 1. Town Attorney combined SIP Checklist, CSP Checklist, Definitions, and Timeline into the "Hillside Safety Improvement Measures and Process Manual" (simpler for cross reference)
- 2. Staff updated material for Manual, Blasting Ordinance and overall Hillside Safety Ordinance.
- 3. Councilmembers Moore and Pace did review and edit of documents.
- 4. Staff incorporated edits.
- 5. Sent to professional editors and all parties looked at it again.
 - Final versions in packet.

Notable Revisions

- Language on video recording in Blasting Ordinance
 - Upon successful contact with the owner/occupant and with written consent of the owner/occupant, the applicant shall submit a video record of the exterior of the owner/occupant's structure within the pre-blast area and provide a copy of the video to the Town and the owner/occupant prior to commencement of blasting.



Notable Revisions

- Ordinance 2018-09 adds Hillside Pre-application to Ch.2
- Manual is an appendix to Ordinance 2018-09 so don't need a resolution, only the ordinance.
- Action requires adoption 2018-09 and Ordinance 2018-13 modifying the Blasting Ordinance.
