- 2 WHEREAS, on June 19, 2018 the Paradise Valley Planning Commission held a
- public hearing, as required by law, and voted 7 to 0, to forward the Visually Significant
- 4 Corridors Master Plan to the Town Council with a recommendation that it be adopted
- 5 as a specific plan; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed and received public comment on
- 7 the Visually Significant Corridors Master Plan; and believes the adoption of this plan
- 8 is in the best interest of the Town.

- aimed at implementing the Visually Significant Corridors Master Plan.
