KEY QUESTION

 Does the Council wish to amend the definition of "Small Wireless Facility" in Town Code Section 2-5-2(I)(2)(I) as set forth in the Ordinance No. 2019-08?



BACKGROUND

 At its study session on May 23, 2019 the Council reviewed draft Ordinance No. 2019-08 that suggested clarification to the definition of "Small Wireless Facility" in the Town Code, in conjunction with the upcoming adoption of the MLA



TOWN CODE CHANGES – SECTION 2-5-2(I)(2)(I)

- l) "Small Wireless Facility" or "SWF" means any of several technologies using radio signals at various frequencies to send and receive voice, data or video to and from mobile transceivers, which are composed of a faux cactus that houses Antennas internally or a replacement Utility Pole that has Antennas that are no more than six cubic feet in volume, AND any of the following: two (2) or more of the following components:
 - i. Antennas that are no more than six cubic feet in volume;
 - ii. Faux Cactus or replacement Utility Pole;
 - ii. Equipment cabinet less than twenty-eight cubic feet in volume; or
 - iiv. Underground vault for equipment; or
 - iiiv. Electric meter (where required by law); or
 - iv. Grounding Equipment and a power transfer switch.
