25	the license fees and all other lawful charges imposed by cities and towns, and requirement
26	that the provider comply with federal, state and local laws, consumer privacy mandates and
27	public, education and government programming requirements; and
28	WHEREAS, the Town Council approved the standard Uniform Video License
29	Agreement, Application form, and Affidavit at its June 13, 2019, meeting; and
30	WHEREAS, The Town Council desires to authorize the Mayor to execute, on behalf
