9 **A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE**
10 **TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING**
11 **AUTHORITY FOR THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE STANDARD**
12 **UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR VIDEO**
13 **SERVICE PROVIDERS**

15 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL**
16 **OF THE TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:**

17 WHEREAS, in 2018, the Arizona Legislature enacted Senate Bill 1140 (the uniform
18 video services license legislation) that requires cities and Towns to adopt a standard uniform
19 video service license agreement and application by July 1, 2019; and

20 WHEREAS, by state statute, cities and towns are also required to issue uniform
21 video service licenses to video service providers; and

22 WHEREAS, the uniform video services license agreement contains sixteen separate
23 provisions including the date on which the provider expects to provide video services in the
24 area, a description of the service area to be served, a requirement that the provider will pay
25 the license fees and all other lawful charges imposed by cities and towns, and requirement
26 that the provider comply with federal, state and local laws, consumer privacy mandates and
27 public, education and government programming requirements; and

28 WHEREAS, the Town Council approved the standard Uniform Video License
29 Agreement, Application form, and Affidavit at its June 13, 2019, meeting; and

30 WHEREAS, The Town Council desires to authorize the Mayor to execute, on behalf
31 of the Town, Uniform Video License Agreements with applicants, provided that the
32 applicant has submitted the appropriate application and affidavit, and indicates that it will

1 execute the Uniform Video Services License without any changes or modifications.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

3 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of
4 the Town, Uniform Video License Agreements with applicants provided that the applicant
5 has submitted the appropriate application and affidavit, and indicates that it will execute the
6 Uniform Video Services License without any changes or modifications.
