Jason, On January 7th 2020 I went out to 6400 E. Cactus wren road in Paradise Valley, AZ. We pulled the 3 hp well pump, pipe and wire out of the well. We then dug down about 2' around the well head. Then we cut off the 2' top piece of the 8" well surface casing and welded a plate to seal the well from and run off that would be able to get inside the well and or water table. We also disconnected the two 120 gallon pressure tanks and the tank pads that we also near the well on the property. There is a 10,000 gallon underground steel storage tank that we cut off the 4" riser and sealed the 4" hole with a threaded cap. At that point everything was loaded up and taken off the property.
