TOWN OF PARADISE VALLEY Lincoln Drive Median Improvements Construction Contract Discussion





PROJECT OVERVIEW

This construction contract will include two specific phases of improvements on Lincoln Drive:

- 1. Reconstruct Lincoln Dr. Medians between 32nd St. and Tatum Blvd.
- 2. Reconstruct Lincoln Dr. Medians between Tatum Blvd. and Mockingbird Ln.

Other ancillary projects, not in this contract but also in preparation for the Lincoln Drive Mill and Overlay include:

- Lincoln Dr. & Invergordon Rd. Intersection Improvements Construction contract previously approved by Town Council on May 14th
- 2. Design Lincoln Dr. and Tatum Blvd. Intersection Enhanced Crosswalks per Visually Significant Corridor Master Plan – Proposed to be moved to FY23 with CIP budget update



PROJECT SCOPE

Project Scope:

- Modify, Add/Remove Medians for improved safety, traffic operations and landscaping
- Median Access Priority:
 - a. Police Department & Fire Station No. 2
 - b. Resorts & Places of Worship
 - c. Signalized Intersections & Major Side Streets
 - d. Residential Driveways (Approximately 80)
- Install Irrigation To Medians East of Tatum Blvd.
- Install landscaping In Medians
- Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Improvements (spare conduit for future use)
- Met with Resorts & Places of Worship to review initial median concepts
- Met with Council Members and Town Manager to review initial median concepts
- Council Work Study presentations on November 21, 2019 and February 27, 2020



PROJECT SCHEDULE

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Anticipated Project Schedule:

- Construction contract approval on June 11th or June 25th
- Tatum Blvd. to Mockingbird Lane = 3 months
- Tatum Blvd. to 32nd St. = 2 months
- It is anticipated that the contractor would start work at Tatum Blvd. and work east towards Mockingbird Ln.



- Proposed FY21 CIP budget based on engineer's estimate at 30% design
- Actual costs provided by Town's Contractor on 95% plans
- Identified items to reduce costs to align with budget on following slides

Lincoln Drive West of Tatum	\$ 675,000	\$ 914,000	\$ 239,000
Lincoln Drive East of Tatum	\$ 1,475,000	\$ 1,583,000	\$ 108,000
Contingency	\$ 0	\$ 75,000	\$ 75,000
Total	\$ 2,150,000	\$ 2,572,000	\$ 422,000



Proposed scope modifications and pricing adjustments


- Staff met with design engineer and contractor to verify 95% construction plans scope and assumptions.
- Staff has requested contractor to go back to subcontractors for lower pricing and to look at lower pricing on self performed items. Current quote does not include any revised pricing.
- ITS fiber conduit from Lincoln Dr. main conduit run to traffic signals previously added to plans (\$110,000 plus markups). Staff to verify if this work can be done with future fiber project without cutting asphalt.



Proposed scope modifications and pricing adjustments

- Staff and design engineer met to review median layout to see if any adjustments to median layouts can be made to reduce scope of work.
- Any proposed median layout modifications would not adversely affect access to resorts, places of worship or residential properties.
- Design engineer to review landscaping quantities for savings.
- Engineering staff to re-review condition of existing medians and curbs from Tatum Boulevard to 32nd Street

- Present options within budget to Town Council at June 11th Work Study
- Construction contract within budget for approval at June 11th or June 25th Council meeting
