RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the approval of an IGA substantially similar to the attached with Maricopa County to provide Animal Care and Control services.

SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Town of Paradise Valley has had a long-standing relationship with Maricopa County to provide animal care and control services for Paradise Valley. Maricopa County provides services including bite investigations, bite follow up, housing of strays and returning strays to rightful owners.

The Town currently has a three-year IGA with Maricopa County to provide animal control services, which expires 06/30/2021. The expiring IGA included an increase of 3% during each year of the IGA. This one-year IGA reflects a 3% increase above the costs outlined in the expiring IGA.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

During FY 21/22, \$11,215 has been requested for this IGA.
