# 20-428 2022 General Plan Update - Draft Public Involvement Plan (PIP)

Special Projects Planner Loras Rauch and Matthew Klyszeiko of Michael Baker International summarized the comprehensive plan to involve the public in the General Plan Update process.

Mr. Klyszeiko identified the main stakeholders, described the proposed engagement techniques, and explained the timeline. It was anticipated that the Plan would be placed on the August 2022 ballot for voter ratification.

The Council provided feedback on community outreach and branding.

# 20-429 Discussion and Possible Direction Regarding the FY2020/21 Monthly Financial Update No. 3 for November 2020

Chief Financial Officer Douglas Allen presented the monthly financial update for November including highlights and analysis of the Town's major revenue sources: retail & hospitality, bed tax, state shared revenue, construction sales tax, and building permits. Generally, revenue collections were meeting the definition of Level II – the pandemic has not materially impacted the Town. Revenues remain steady or slightly reduced.

He summarized three recommended CIP budget transfers including the Lincoln Median Project, utility relocations on Lincoln Drive east of Tatum Blvd, and sewer pipe lining project.

The Council discussed the timing of the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System unfunded liability payments. Due to the uncertain financial climate, there was consensus to hold off on making payments until later in calendar year 2021.
