**A motion was made by Council Member Dembow, seconded by Council Member Andeen, to adjourn. The motion carried by the following vote:**

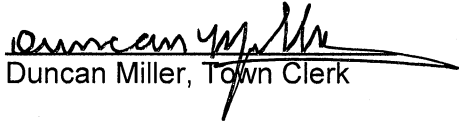

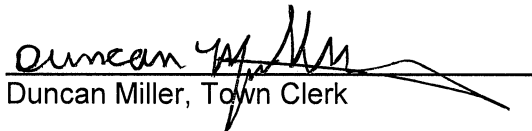
