Approve Emily Kile to serve a one-year term as Chair of the Board of Adjustment

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**  
On April 5, 2017, the Board of Adjustment selected Emily Kile to serve a one-year term as chair. Pursuant to Town Code Section 2-5-3, the Council must either approve or reject the selection within 30-days. Board Members are allowed to serve two consecutive terms as chair.

Emily Kile has served on the Board of Adjustment since 2004. She is a graduate of the Northeastern School of Law in Boston, Massachusetts. She is a practicing attorney with Kile & Kupiszewski focusing on estate planning and related matters, including Medicaid (ALTCS), VA and long term care planning, special needs planning, guardianship and conservatorship issues and estate settlement/probate. The Supreme Court of Arizona appointed her to serve on the Fiduciary

Board. The Fiduciary Board oversees the approval and discipline of fiduciaries licensed in the State of Arizona by the Supreme Court.
