### RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution Number 2020-19 Approving the Annual PSPRS Pension Funding Policy for Fiscal Year 2021.

### SUMMARY STATEMENT:

- u State law requires the annual adoption of a PSPRS pension funding policy.
- u This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of this annual process.
- u The Arizona League of Cities and Towns has provided a template.
- u Town Council has also provided guidance under Council Resolution number 2016-19 Declaring the expedient resolution of the PSPRS unfunded liability a priority.
- u Presented for Council's consideration is Resolution 2020-19 to adopt a PSPRS policy that:
  - Meets state requirements;

- Amortizes the liability at the maximum time allowed to give flexibility and not over commit the Town in economic downturns; and
- Reaffirms Town Council's declared priority to pay the unfunded liability as quick as reasonably possible with cash payments.
